ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE OF RENEWAL OF BUSINESS PERMITS FROM JANUARY 20 TO FEBRUARY 28, 2022 WITHOUT SURCHARGES AND PENALTIES

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) issued Resolution No. 152 on December 2, 2021, citing, among others, that "Areas under Alert Level 2 may be escalated to Alert Level 3 if both case classification and total COVID-19 bed utilization are at moderate risk; or if case classification is at high to critical risk.";

WHEREAS, Metro Manila has been placed under Alert Level 3 due to the increasing number of COVID-19 positive cases from January 3 to 15, 2022 which affects the livelihood of people;

WHEREAS, the extension of deadline for the renewal of business permits will help eliminate congestion and avoid the spread of the virus;

WHEREAS, Section 167 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that:

"SECTION 167. Time of Payment. – Unless otherwise provided in this Code, all local taxes, fees and charges shall be paid within the first twenty (20) days of January or of each subsequent quarter, as the case may be. The sanggunian concerned may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the time for payment of such taxes, fees, or charges without surcharges or penalties, but only for a period not exceeding six (6) months."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MARIKINA in a session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The City Government of Marikina hereby extends the deadline of renewal of Business Permits from January 20 to February 28, 2022 without surcharges and penalties due to the COVID-19 pandemic.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
