BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
MARIKINA in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. CREATION. The Marikina City Anti-Smoking Task Force is hereby created.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The Marikina City Anti-Smoking Task Force shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson : *City Mayor*
Co-Chairperson : *City Health Officer*
Members : *Chairperson, City Council Committee on Health and Sanitation*
Chief, Office of Public Safety and Security
Chief, Business Permits and Licensing Office
City Engineer
City Market Administrator
Chief, Marikina City Police Station
Chief, Public Information Office
Chairpersons of All Barangay

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*Kagawad for Health of All Barangays
Kabataan Kontra Yosi (KAKONYO) (Non-Government Organization)*

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Marikina City Anti-Smoking Task Force shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- 3.1 Enforce applicable sections of Republic Act No. 9211 otherwise known as Tobacco Regulation Act of 2003;
- 3.2 Enforce local ordinances in relation to tobacco, e-cigarette and vape;
- 3.3 Assist and report to the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) such business establishments who will be found violating the provisions of R.A. 9211 and the local ordinances in relation to tobacco, e-cigarette and vape;
- 3.4 Conduct anti-smoking campaign in collaboration with the Philippine National Police of Marikina City

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION. The City Legal Office, Business Permits and Licensing Office, Office of Public Safety and Security and the Philippine National Police – Marikina City is hereby tasked to formulate the implementing rules and regulations of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS. The City Government shall integrate resource requirements to support the creation of the Task Force and the implementation of its mandate and other related plans, programs and activities.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances and administrative regulations or part/s thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


