ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XV, SECTION 107 (a) OF ORDINANCE NO. 133, SERIES OF 2006, ENTITLED: "ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2006 TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CODE OF MARIKINA CITY"

WHEREAS, Section 107 (a) of the 2006 Traffic Management Code of Marikina City states that:

"SECTION 107. Truck Routes and Limited Truck Ban –

(a) Cargo trucks, gravel and sand trucks, and other heavy-tonnage cargo trucks with eight (8) wheels and up, or whose gross vehicle weight exceed 4,500 kilograms, including tractor trailers or containerized haulers, shall not be allowed to travel on any City streets with no more than two (2) lanes, except along the streets specified as truck routes in Appendix "A". The use of the truck routes shall be restricted to the hours between 9:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M., and from 9:00 P.M. through 5:00 A.M. of the following day."

WHEREAS, however it has been observed that more vehicles and commuters are coming out during those times which causes heavier flow of traffic thus the need to amend the specific provision of the Ordinance for truck ban;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a), sub-paragraph (5) (v) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that:

(a) The sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative of the city, shall enact ordinance, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:

(3) Approve ordinances which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code, and in addition to said services and facilities, shall:

(v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges x x x;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL of MARIKINA, in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. The City Government of Marikina hereby amends Article XV, Section 107 (a) of Ordinance No. 133, Series of 2006 to be read as:


“SECTION 107. Truck Routes and Limited Truck Ban –

(a) Cargo trucks, gravel and sand trucks, and other heavy-tonnage cargo trucks with eight (8) wheels and up, or whose gross vehicle weight exceed 4,500 kilograms, including tractor trailers or containerized haulers, shall not be allowed to travel on any City streets with no more than two (2) lanes, except along the streets specified as truck routes in Appendix “A”. Truck ban shall be implemented from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.”

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
