ORDINANCE DECLARING A FIVE-YEAR (5) MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT/CONSTRUCTION OF NEW GASOLINE, DIESEL AND KEROSENE STATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF MARIKINA

WHEREAS, it has been widely observed that a considerable number of gasoline stations have been established in the stretch of Marikina over the years, with Gil Fernando Avenue alone having six (6) gasoline stations;

WHEREAS, as of present time, there are Thirty-Five existing gasoline stations operating within the City and way over its subscription;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Marikina aspiring to entice and encourage more business enterprises to invest in the City, deems that a five-year moratorium on the establishment/construction of new gasoline stations will be more conducive to other type of businesses and also to avoid over subscription of gasoline stations within the City;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 002 Series of 2015 declaring a five (5) year moratorium on the establishment/construction of new gasoline, diesel and kerosene stations within the City of Marikina expired last February 4, 2020. Which re-imposition is earnestly sought by the City Council;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that:

General Welfare.- Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions shall ensure and support, among other things x x x enhance economic prosperity and social justice x x x

WHEREAS, Section 458, No. 2 paragraph (vi) of the same Code states that the sanggunian as the legislative body of the city shall:

“Prescribe reasonable limits and restraints on the use of property within the jurisdiction of the city”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the **SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MARIKINA**, in session, duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance hereby declares a five (5) year moratorium on the establishment/construction of new gasoline, diesel and kerosene stations within the City of Marikina.

SECTION 2. Expansions, renovations of existing gasoline, diesel and kerosene stations within their lots/properties and change of ownerships and dealerships are not covered by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.



ENACTED by the **CITY COUNCIL of MARIKINA** during its **30th Regular Session**, this **5th day of August 2020**.


