ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 57, SERIES OF 1999 ENTITLED –
“ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF GARBAGE, TRASH OR ANY
OTHER REFUSE MATERIALS IN STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC
PLACES”

Introduced by Councilor ROBERTO C. PONCE
and Vice-Mayor DEL R. de GUZMAN

WHEREAS, on March 17, 1999 the City Council of Marikina enacted Ordinance No. 57, Series of 1999 which prohibits the burning of garbage, trash or any other refuse materials in streets, sidewalks and other public places in Marikina City;

WHEREAS, however, it was observed that some city residents are burning their garbage and other domestic refuse within their private yards or on vacant private lots;

WHEREAS, the smoke and stench emitted by this garbage burning are causing air pollution and serve as nuisance to the affected neighborhood;

WHEREAS, this burning activity likewise poses threat to public health and poses as a danger that could trigger a big fire as glowing embers therefrom can be windblown to any nearby flammable materials;

WHEREAS, to ensure public safety and for the protection of the environment, the burning of garbage in private yards and /or private lots should be prohibited.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL of MARIKINA, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The title of Ordinance No. 59, Series of 1999 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF GARBAGE, TRASH OR ANY OTHER REFUSE MATERIALS IN STREETS, SIDEWALKS, AND IN ANY PLACE, WHETHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE, WITHIN THE CITY OF MARIKINA”

SECTION 2. Section 1 of the same Ordinance is likewise amended to read as follows:


“SECTION 1. The burning of garbage, trash, solid waste, or any other refuse material in any place, whether public or private, within the City of Marikina is hereby prohibited.”

SECTION 3. The City Council Secretary is hereby directed to furnish copies of this Ordinance to the presidents of all accredited homeowners/community associations, through the Community Relations Office, the Marikina Settlements Office, and all Barangay Councils of Marikina..


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation or local circulation.
