**ORDINANCE GRANTING RELIEF ON RENTAL PAYMENTS TO
STALLHOLDERS IN THE WET AND DRY SECTIONS OF THE CITY PUBLIC
MARKET FOR THE MONTHS OF MARCH AND APRIL 2020**

WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines issued Presidential Decree No. 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines, enjoining all Local Government Units to render full assistance and cooperation to undertake appropriate response to curtail the spread of the COVID-19 threat;

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued a Resolution recommending for an enhanced community quarantine which was adopted by the Office of the President after the Covid-19 reached Code Red Sublevel 2;

WHEREAS, the enhanced community quarantine resulted to suspension of mass transport, work and class suspensions, travel restrictions, closure of offices and establishments other than those exempted establishments;

WHEREAS, people were likewise prohibited from leaving their homes unless to access basic needs and services;

WHEREAS, the impact of the enhanced community quarantine brought financial difficulties and unrealized revenue to stallholders in the City Public Market both in the wet and dry sections;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code, or the General Welfare Clause provides that every local government unit shall exercise powers necessary to ensure and promote, among other things, social justice and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 192, of the same Code provides that, “Local Government Units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or relief under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary”.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the **SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG MARIKINA**, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. - This ordinance shall be known as “ORDINANCE GRANTING RELIEF ON RENTAL PAYMENTS TO STALLHOLDERS IN THE WET AND DRY SECTIONS OF THE CITY PUBLIC MARKET FOR THE MONTHS OF MARCH AND APRIL 2020”.


SECTION 2. Coverage. - The relief hereto granted covers the waiver of rental payments for March and April 2020.

SECTION 3. Separability Clause. - Should any provisions, section, or part of this ordinance be adjudged or declared illegal or unconstitutional, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, or part which shall continue to be in full force and effect;


SECTION 4. Effectivity. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
