**ORDINANCE GRANTING RELIEF ON RENTAL PAYMENTS TO
STALLHOLDERS IN THE DRY GOODS SECTION OF THE CITY PUBLIC
MARKET FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2021**

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2020, the President of the Philippines issued Proclamation No. 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, it was followed by the declaration of State of Calamity throughout the Philippines which was contained in Proclamation No. 929 issued by the President on March 16, 2020;

WHEREAS, the state of calamity was further extended until September of the current year due to the rise in number of COVID-19 positive cases which was contained in Proclamation No. 1021 issued by the President on September 16, 2020;

WHEREAS, with the detection of various COVID-19 variants, the global pandemic is still continuing, and in fact has driven a surge in new cases in Metro Manila during the first quarter of the year;

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2021, National Inter-Agency Task Force issued Resolution No. 106-A which effectively placed the entire National Capital Region (NCR) Plus

on Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) imposing more stringent restrictions on mobility and limiting outside activities to the most essential in protection of public health and safety;

WHEREAS, with these prevailing conditions, businesses in the dry goods section of the Marikina Public Market can be considered as badly hit by the crisis, thus this ordinance;

WHEREAS, Section 192 of the Local Government Code provides that:

“Local government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary.”

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MARIKINA, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as “ORDINANCE GRANTING RELIEF ON RENTAL PAYMENTS TO STALLHOLDERS IN THE DRY GOODS SECTION OF THE CITY PUBLIC MARKET FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2021”.

SECTION 2. Coverage. The relief hereto granted covers waiver of rental payments of stallholders in the Dry Good Section of the City Public Market for the month of April 2021 only.

SECTION 3. Credit of Rental Payment. Rental Payments made for April 2021 shall be credited or applied to subsequent rents.

SECTION 4. Separability Clause. If for any reason or reasons, any part of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 5. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


