**ORDINANCE FURTHER EXTENDING THE FIRST QUARTER DEADLINE OF
PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY TAX (RPT) TO MAY 30, 2020 AS A FORM
OF RELIEF TO TAX PAYERS AFFECTED BY THE ENHANCED
COMMUNITY QUARANTINE**

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2020, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 031, Series of 2020 which provided for the extension of the first quarter deadline of payment of Real Property Tax to April 30, 2020 as a form of relief to tax payers affected by the enhanced community quarantine;

WHEREAS, however, President Rodrigo Duterte extended the Enhanced Community Quarantine in National Capital Region, Central Luzon and CALABARZON until May 15, 2020 to stop the spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the impact of the prolonged enhanced community quarantine brought about the closure of unnecessary business establishments and the stoppage of work of most people, including the constituents of the City;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code, or the General Welfare Clause provides that every local government unit shall exercise powers necessary to ensure and promote, among other things, social justice and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 192, of the same Code provides that, “Local Government Units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or relief under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary”.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the **SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD** of **MARIKINA**, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The City Government of Marikina hereby extends further the first quarter deadline of payment of Real Property Tax (RPT) to May 30, 2020 as a form of relief to real property tax payers affected by the enhanced community quarantine imposed in the country at present.

SECTION 2. By extending the deadline of payment, interests and penalties shall no longer apply when payment is made within the extended period herein provided.

SECTION 3. *Prompt Payment.* - The Ten Percent (10%) prompt payment discount as provided for under Ordinance No. 09, Series of 2019 shall likewise apply to Real Property Tax paid on or before May 30, 2020.

SECTION 4. *Repealing Clause.* - All local ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 5. *Effectivity.* - This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
