WHEREAS, Section 166 of Ordinance No. 133, Series of 2006 provides for the incentives distribution out of the collection of fines and penalties for all traffic violations;

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2018 Section 166 of Ordinance No. 133, Series of 2016 was amended by Ordinance No. 053, Series of 2018 mainly due to the merging of the City Transportation Management and Development Office (CTMDO) to the Office of Public Safety and Security (OPSS);

WHEREAS, the amendment this time pertains to the manner on how the share of the OPSS will be utilized by the City Government of Marikina;

WHEREAS, the existing ordinance provides that the incentives granted to the OPSS shall be subject to the approval of the Honorable City Mayor, and shall be used only as funds for their activity-related functions and logistic requirements of their respective units that include maintenance of their facilities;

WHEREAS, however, there are other transportation related programs of the City Government that needed funding and the share of the OPSS can be a good source of fund for said purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the **SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MARIKINA**, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Last paragraph of Section 166 of Ordinance No. 133, Series of 2006, as amended by Ordinance No. 053, Series of 2018 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Except for Item (a) above where the incentive shall accrue to the personal account of the traffic enforcer and Item (d) which will accrue to the general fund of the City Government, the incentives granted to the OPSS and PNP Traffic shall be subject to the approval of the Honorable City Mayor, and shall be used as funds for their activity-related functions, logistical requirements for activities/programs of their respective units, including establishment/improvement of terminal and transport-facilities, assistance/support to transport groups in uniforms, equipment and other provisions, promotion and/or procurement of alternative mode of transportation, and other transport-related projects, programs, and activities of the City Government of Marikina. Disbursements therefrom shall be subject to proper accounting and auditing requirements. Any unused balance at the end of the fiscal year in excess of twenty five percent (25%) of the previous year’s expenditures shall revert back to the General Fund of the City.”


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
