**RESOLUTION DECLARING MARIKINA CITY UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE DEVASTATING EFFECTS OF TYPHOON "CRISING" AND THE INTENSIFIED SOUTHWEST MONSOON ("HABAGAT"), WHICH HAS RESULTED IN WIDESPREAD FLOODING IN LOW-LYING BARANGAYS, CAUSING DAMAGE TO PROPERTIES AND DISRUPTING THE LIVES OF RESIDENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marikina experienced heavy and incessant rainfall for several days since Monday, July 21, due to the enhanced southwest monsoon ("Habagat") intensified by Typhoon "Crising";

**WHEREAS**, said heavy rains resulted in widespread flooding affecting numerous barangays in Marikina City, submerging low-lying areas near the river and causing significant damage to property and infrastructure;

**WHEREAS**, many areas in Marikina City remain submerged as of July 22, posing an ongoing threat to public safety and well-being;

**WHEREAS**, the Marikina City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MCDRRMC) conducted initial assessments and determined the extent of the damage and the urgent need for immediate action to provide relief, support, and assistance to affected residents and barangays;

**WHEREAS**, the extent of damage to property, infrastructure, and the continuing threat to public safety necessitate the declaration of a state of calamity to facilitate the efficient and effective utilization of resources for relief, rehabilitation, and recovery efforts;

**WHEREAS**, Section 458 (1) (iv) of Republic Act No. 7160 states that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall "Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events";

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the **SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MARIKINA**, in session duly assembled, to declare Marikina City under the State of Calamity due to the devastating effects of Typhoon "Crising" and the intensified southwest monsoon (Habagat), which has resulted in widespread flooding in low-lying barangays, causing damage to properties and disrupting the lives of the residents;


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to authorize the City Mayor to utilize all available resources of the City Government, including the quick response fund, to implement necessary relief, rescue, rehabilitation, and recovery operations in the affected areas within the city and coordinate with national government agencies, national government organizations, and other stakeholders to ensure a comprehensive disaster response and facilitate recovery efforts;

**RESOLVED FURTHERMORE**, to direct the MCDRRMC to continuously monitor the situation, conduct regular assessments of the damage, and provide regular updates to the Sangguniang Panlungsod on the progress of relief and rehabilitation efforts;


**RESOLVED FINALLY**, to furnish a copy of this Resolution to the Honorable City Mayor Marjorie Ann A. Teodoro, the Honorable Secretary Juanito Victor C. Remulla of the Department of the Interior and Local Government, other concerned national government agencies and offices, for their information and appropriate action.

**ADOPTED**, by the **SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MARIKINA**, this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2025.


